How can L.I.F.E. help to solve these problems? L.I.F.E. is a co-operative (co-op) organization dedicated to reducing our environmental impact by investing in renewable energy programs. How does a co-op work? Each person who belongs to the co-op buys a membership that allows them a vote in how the co-op is run, as well as an opportunity to receive dividends from the co-op when available. The member may also choose to lend money to the co-op. By doing so, the member will receive interest payments on their investment and repayment of the principal. The money lent to the co-op will be invested in renewable energy programs, such as wind turbines, biomass and other alternative energy projects.
